Youth Education

THE COTTAGE PROGRAM

The Cottage Program is designed for young people who suffer from acute social anxiety or due to a range of physical, social or emotional reasons experience barriers to attending education within a mainstream School environment. The Cottage program provides a quiet and supportive learning environment developed to support and encourage young people to complete their studies or to re-engage back into education.

Whilst the program is focused on building literacy, numeracy and digital literacy skills students are encouraged and supported in building social connections. Learning extends beyond the classroom and encourages the student to better understand and manage their ongoing physical health and wellbeing. Offering;

22472VIC Certificate I in General Education for Adults 22473VIC Certificate II in General Education for Adults 22474VIC Certificate III in General Education for Adults

Students must be over the age of 15 years by the 1st of January in each given year to enrol. Minimum literacy and numeracy skills apply.




