
































## Analysis – 2019

The completion rate for Foundation VCAL increased from 2018 to 2019 with 42% of students completing compared to 32% in 2018. The enrolment rate was steady at 44%.

Completion rates for Intermediate and Senior VCAL were lower with fewer completions and a lower rate of completion of units of competency. The completion rate for Intermediate VCAL dropped to 5% in 2019 and for Senior VCAL the completion rate dropped to 30% in 2019.

Many students required additional supports to be put in place before learning could be progressed. Once student issues were addressed, students could continue their course as highlighted in the percentage of students who continued their education at MDLC in 2020. Students who went on to further study outside MDLC was higher than the previous year.

Of the Intermediate VCAL students enrolled at MDLC in 2019: 32% re-enrolled in 2020 at MDLC, 41% enrolled in further education outside of MDLC and 18% found employment.

For Senior VCAL students 40% re-enrolled in 2020 to complete their course and 50% found employment. Improved opportunities for apprenticeships, traineeships and jobs allowed students to more easily pathway into further studies and employment after completing their course.
